Key Takeaways

- Americans of all ages and political persuasions <u>love</u> ice cream. Vanilla reigns supreme as the public's favorite flavor, with chocolate and strawberry rounding out the top 3. Mint chocolate chip, butter pecan, and cookies & cream each have strong contingents who prefer them over all other options. Flavor is consumers' top consideration when choosing between ice creams, with price and quantity also factoring in heavily.
- The public has clear preferences when it comes to how they consume their ice cream. Hot fudge, whipped cream, and caramel sauce stand out as the most popular toppings, while the top fruit and nut mix-ins are strawberries and pecans/peanuts, respectively. Most adults lick the ice cream first when eating an ice cream cone, though are more likely than others to bite it instead.
- When asked to <u>compare</u> the United States Congress to a flavor of ice cream, a plurality of Americans say: Rocky Road *anything but smooth*. A sizable share say instead that Congress is best represented by a banana split *split down the middle*. And in third place: butter pecan *rich and nutty*.













Americans tend to prefer bowls or waffle cones – only one-in-ten say straight out of the carton is their favorite method of consumption.





Generally speaking, how are YOU most likely to approach eating an ice cream cone?



of Americans say their favorite place to eat ice cream is <u>at home</u>.


Adults over 45 especially prefer eating ice cream at home. Young adults (18-34) are more likely than other groups to say *outdoors* is their favorite setting for it.





Flavor is the most important consideration when consumers are weighing ice cream options, though four-fifths of adults think size and price are important as well. Nutritional info and product packaging carry less weight.

Across demographic subgroups, flavor is the top determinant of ice cream choice. Younger (<35) adults care less about brand names for ice cream than others surveyed.



Larger shares of women, adults over 45, and white adults describe Congress as Rocky Road ice cream - anything but smooth.





How would you describe your feelings toward ice cream in general?




Which of the following, if any, is your favorite type of ice cream novelty? Select one.






Which of the following is your favorite ice cream topping?







